West Hallam Village Show Schedule 2020

Fruit & Vegetables:

Class 1: 3 carrots, parsnips or beetroot of one variety, tops trimmed to about 6"

Class 2: 4 potatoes of one variety, washed

Class 3: 5 tomatoes, of one variety, with calyx

Class 4: 7 cherry tomatoes, with calyx

Class 5: 4 runner beans

Class 6: 3 apples, of one variety

Class 7: any other vegetable: **judged to equal points**, including rhubarb. 2 samples, or 1 cabbage etc.

Class 8: any other fruit, not in schedule, of one variety – **excluding** rhubarb – an appropriate number

N.B. fruit and vegetables must be displayed on paper plates (not provided)

Best in Show (Fruit & Veg): £5 prize sponsored by Paul & Mary Butler

Flowers:

Class 9: 3 blooms of one variety, displayed in a vase (*vase not provided*)

Class 10: mixed vase of flowers (*no additional foliage*)

Class 11: potted house plant, flowering or foliage, **judged to equal points**

Bakery:

Class 12: Victoria sandwich, 8" tin, 3 large eggs, raspberry jam filling, caster sugar topping

Class 13: Apple cake, made to the set recipe with the entry form

Class 14: Savoury quiche made using shortcrust pastry

Class 15: 4 savoury scones

Class 16: 2lb loaf of bread

Class 17: Junior bakery – up to 14 years - gingerbread man or woman – suitably decorated

NB: all baked goods must be displayed on a crockery plate (not provided).

Best in Show (Bakery): £5 prize sponsored by West Hallam & District WI

Preserves:

Class 18: a 1lb jar of jam (any variety); *must have cellophane top*

Class 19: a 1lb jar of chutney; *should have metal cap; label must indicate mild/
medium/ hot*

*N.B. preserves must be in glass jars and must be labelled, including date when
made*

Crafts:

Class 20: a hand-knitted garment, suitable for an adult or child (**not** hats, scarves
or gloves)

Class 21: any other hand-made item using **any other craft** (excluding knitting)

Class 22: a knitted toy

Best in Show (Crafts): £5 prize sponsored by West Hallam Craft Group

Art:

Class 23: a piece, any medium, subject: '**The Winter Landscape**'; maximum size
framed / unframed 2' x 2'

N.B. exhibitors may bring table-top easels to display paintings

Photography:

Class 24: a colour photograph; theme '**Friendship**'. Open to all ages

*N.B. only natural photographs will be judged – no Photo-Shop enhancements
Photos not to exceed 6" x 8" and to be mounted on card suitable for pinning to a display board; the
mount will not be judged*

Children:

Class 25: (*11 years and under*) a Lego Model;
(*no larger than 12"x12"/30cm x 30cm approx.*)

Class 26: (*11 years and under*): a Fruit and/or Vegetable character using any fruit
or vegetable
